

# Welcome entries in juried sculpture show

STOUFFVILLE — A Juried Sculpture Exhibition entitled 'Dimensional Diversions' will be hosted by Stouffville's Latcham Gallery. It's open to sculptors from all over Ontario. The grand opening is Thurs., April 24 from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m. Deliveries to the Gallery must be made on one of three dates: Thurs., April 17 from 9 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.; Fri., April 18 from 9 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.; or Sat., April 19 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The entry fee is five dollars.

A maximum of two sculptures per person is permitted, executed within the last two years. Maximum size is 82" by 56". Entry forms can be filled out at the Gallery when each work is submitted. The sculptures will be juried April 21. The judges' decision will be revealed at that time. The jurors are—Ron Baird, sculptor; Bill Lishman, sculptor and William Moore, painter. Cash awards of \$150, \$100 and \$50 will be presented.

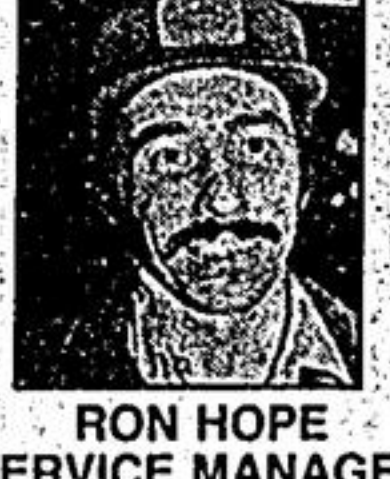

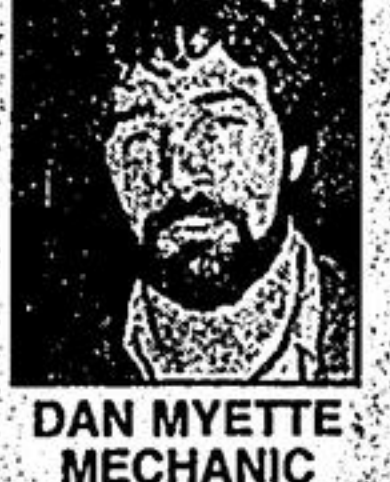
